# Request for Jurisdictional Inspection of Pressure Equipment

---

## Important Information

Every owner of a boiler or pressure vessel must ensure periodic inspections are performed, in accordance with the requirements of the jurisdiction in which they are installed and operated; owners must also have a current Certificate of Inspection in place to permit operation of the boiler or pressure vessel. Periodic inspections are required to renew these certificates. In the provinces of Ontario & Quebec, as part of the CNA equipment breakdown coverage, CNA Canada has employees who have been licensed and authorized to perform these inspections.

### If:

- You own/operate pressure equipment that requires a certificate in the provinces of Ontario & Quebec, to operate legally, and
- We insure that equipment under this Policy, and
- You would like CNA to perform the next required inspection

- Effective July 1, 2018, you will be required to obtain the Certificate of Inspection from T.S.S.A. for a fee. For more information, please visit T.S.S.A.'s website.
