
First Fill Process

FIRST FILL PROCESS

- Employer provides form to injured employee with their Name and Date-of-Injury filled out
- Injured employee provides form and prescription to network pharmacy
- The pharmacy calls First Script to verify eligibility information and to get the Member ID#
- The pharmacy fills approved prescription
